UACCB to offer ACT® math prep course

BATESVILLE – The University of Arkansas Community College at Batesville’s Community and Technical Education department is offering a math preparatory class that investigates strategies that enable students to achieve higher scores on the math portion of the ACT® Exam. The presenter, Greg Fulton, is a math educator with 36 years of teaching experience, including 28 years preparing high school students for a successful ACT® experience. He currently teaches mathematics at Henderson State University in Arkadelphia and Central Baptist College in Conway. He has earned a bachelor of science degree in biology/mathematics, a master of science in education degree in mathematics and holds public school certification in math and biological science for Arkansas.
